In the Name of God Amen. I Thomas Arnold of Hanover Parish in King George county in the 77th year of my age doth make this my last Will & Testament in manner & form as followeth.

First I bequeath my Soul & Spirit into the hands of my heavenly Father, by whom of his Mercy & only \_\_\_ Grace through the death of my Savior Jesus Christ I entrust to be saved & redeemed to eternal rest. My \_\_\_ body I commit to the Earth to be buried at such rate as my Grace my wife, whom I appoint my Executrice wholly hereinafter named shall think fit.

Item. I do give & bequeath unto my loving wife Grace Arnold my plantation & land so far as to the place where William Harrison's path makes into the side or edge of my plantation or \_\_\_ ground to her proper use & disposing during her natural life and from & after her decease my Will is that the said land hereby given to my Wife as aforesaid doth wholly belong to my son James Arnold & his heirs forever.

Item. That after that part of land hereby given to my Wife & my Son James is by a strait course from the said Harrison's path westerly to Captn. Joseph Strother's line taken to them that the whole remaining part of my land immediately belong to my youngest son John Arnold & his heirs forever and being not indebted & giving the whole of my personal estate to my wife Grace as aforesaid and my Exekutors being ready to give such sekurity as King George County shall think fit.

I wish that my Estate may not be appraised.

I, Isaac Arnold of the Parish of Hanover in King George County, being sick and weak at this time in body but of good & perfect sense & memory do make this my last will in the manner & form following.

First I bequeath my soul & spirit into the hands of Almighty God by whom of his mercy & only \_\_\_\_ grace through the death & merits of my Lord & Saviour Jesus Christ I set the sole & only hope of my salvation. My body I commit to the earth to be buried as my \_\_\_\_ hereafter named shall think fit.

My will is that my eldest son Isaac Arnold do immediately enter into possession of all that tract or parcel of land whereon I formerly did live & inhabit situate in the Parish of Hanover and bounded with the land of Capt. Joseph Murdock & the land of Moses Pittman & others & was given to the sd. Isaac Arnold my sd. son by Thomas Goff grand-father to the sd. Issac Arnold & that the sd. Isaac & his heirs hold & enjoy the sd. land forever.

Item I do give & bequeath unto my sd. eldest son Isaac Arnold one shilling sterling as all his part of my estate.

Item I do give & bequeath unto my daughter Dianah Wharton and Samuel Wharton her now husband all that piece or parcel of land whereon they now live during the whole term of the sd. Dianah her life to live thereon & no further nor otherwise which land is bounded with the road which leads from Duff's Ordinary to King George Courthouse beginning at a marked red oak standing in Capt. Joseph Strother's line on or near the said road thence with the sd. road \_\_\_\_ dividing this land from some other of my land crossing a branch to the line of the land of Mr. John Moor thence with the line of the sd. Moor to three red oaks \_\_\_\_ to this land & in the line of the land of the sd. Strothers thence with the sd. Strother's line to the first station the sd. Samuel not to sell nor waste any timber from \_\_\_\_ the sd. land & that in case the sd. Samuel & Dianah should remove from the sd. land to any other place to live & inhabit before the death of the sd. Dianah the sd. land immediately to return to my wife & her heirs & assigns forever.

Item I give & bequeath unto my son William Arnold one shilling sterling as his part of my estate.

Item I give & bequeath unto my son Benjamin Arnold one shilling sterling as his part of my estate.

Item I do give & bequeath unto my youngest son Mark Arnold one shilling sterling as his part of my estate.

Item I do give & bequeath unto my daughter Sarah Moran one shilling sterling as her part of my estate.

Item I do give & bequeath unto my daughter Isabell Rogers one shilling sterling as her part of my estate.

Item I do give & bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Arnold one shilling sterling as her part of my estate.

Item I do give & bequeath unto my daughter Mary Arnold one shilling sterling as her part of my estate.

Item I do give & bequeath unto my daughter Jemima Arnold one shilling sterling as her part of my estate.

Item I do give & bequeath unto my daughter Susanna Arnold one shilling sterling as her part of my estate.

Item I do give and bequeath unto my well beloved wife Mary Arnold my now dwelling, house & plantation together also with all the land I now have or lay any claim unto also with that other piece or parcel after my daughter Dianah's death which is only to the sd. Dianah for her life all which aforesaid land I do hereby give unto my sd. wife & her heirs & assigns forever & I do so give the premises unto my sd. wife that she my sd. wife may have full power & lawful authority may have full power & lawful authority to lease or sell any part or the whole of the aforesaid land in a full & ample manner & to make a good right thereto as I might or could do were I alive to sell the same myself.

Item I do also give unto my sd. wife all & every part of my personal estate, beds & furniture, household goods of every kind together with all my whole stock of horses, mares, cattle, sheep, hogs with every other thing that belongs to me on or about the sd. plantation.

And my will is that my youngest son Mark Arnold be \_\_\_\_ all services due to me who was eighteen years old the twenty sixth day of July last.

Item And I do make & appoint my loving wife Mary my whole & sole executrix of this my last will revoking & \_\_\_\_ all former & other wills by me heretofore satisfying & declaring this & no other to be my last will & testament & in confirmation thereof I have hereunto set my hand & \_\_\_\_ my seal this thirtieth day of September in the year of our Lord 1757 - Sealed & delivered in presence of - I desire thay my estate may not be brought to an appraisement.

This indenture made the third day of May in the fifth year of the reign of our sovereign Lord George the Second of Great Britain, France & Ireland, King defender of the faith &c., & in the year of our Lord God one thousand seven hundred & thirty three between Isaac Arnold Senr. of the parish of Hannover in King George County withing the Dominion of Virginia of the one part & Thomas Arnold, son of the said Isaac Arnold, of the aforesd parish & county within the dominion of Virginia aforesd planter of the other part.

Witnesseth that the said Isaac Arnold Senr. for in consideration of the natural love, goodwill & affection which he the said Isaac Arnold hath & now beareth to & towards his sd. son Thomas Arnold & for severall other good causes & considerations him the said Isaac Arnold thereunto at this time especially moving hath given, granted, bargained, sold, aliened, \_\_\_\_ & confirmed & in & by these presents doth fully, freely, clearly & absolutely give, grant, bargain, sell, alien & forever confirm unto his said son Thomas Arnold & Mary his now wife to the severall uses herein after mentioned & expressed all that plantation & parcall of land whereon the said Thomas Arnold now liveth & inhabiteth together also with sixty acres of land or thereabout be the same more or less that is to say to the said Thomas & Mary Arnold for & during the whole term of their natural lives & from & after the death of the said Thomas Arnold & Mary his now wife & the survivor & longest liver of them the said land & premises & every part & parcell thereof wholly to belong to Humphrey Arnold, eldest son of the before named Thomas & Mary Arnold which said land is bounded as followeth:

Beginning at the upper corner of the said Thomas Arnold's plantation in a brach which leads into Gingeteague Creek at a red oak standing in or near the line of the land formerly belonging to Mr. Jonathan Gibson running thence with the said line & the line of the land of Mr. Thomas Turner to a small brach which branch divides this said land from the land of the said Isaac Arnold Senr. thence eastwardly down the said branch to the line of Henry Long to the first mentioned branch thence up the said branch to the beginning red oak & being part of a patten for two hundred twenty five acres of land granted to John Doyle Senr. & sold by John Doyle Junr. to the said Isaac Arnold part to these presents \_\_\_\_ in & by the same relation thereto being had may & will more fully & at large appear with all buildings, gardens, orchards, fences, woods & underwoods, timber & timber trees, ways, water & watercourses, priviledges & comodities whatsoever to land & premises aforesd. belonging or in any wise appertaining & the said land & premises & parcell thereof the said Isaac Arnold Senr. doth warrant to the uses aforesd. against the claim or claims of any manner of persons whatsoever claiming from, by or under him the said Isaac Arnold, his heirs & every of his heirs.

Negro girl named Sarah, which I gave John Knowling at his intermarriage with my daughter, and whereas the said Knowling hath sold the said slave to Charles Martin; now be it remembered that in order to settle all future disputes and to confirm the said Martin in his title to the said slave, I do hereby warrant and defend the said slave named Sarah, with all her future increase, to the said Charles Martin, his heirs and assigns forever, against the claim & demand of all and every other person or persons whatsoever.
